# Introduction

Greetings from E-DigiLit Team.

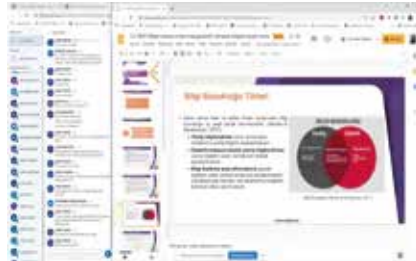
We started piloting process using lesson plans, videos, gamification elements and learning management system developed within the scope of the project.

On 12.11.2021, two-week implementation of the Teacher Training Program on the E-DigiLit project officially ended with ceremonial presentation of the certificates of attendance to 13 participants (teachers of the University of Zagreb, Faculty of Organization and Informatics). With Teacher Training Program they have been acquainted with the curriculum and teaching materials and educated for a piloting of the course Digital Literacy which starts on Wednesday, November 17th 2021 for around 70 first year students from different study programs on Faculty of Organization and Informatics.



# Introduction

Dokuz Eylül University Team started the student pilot study with the participation of 110 student teachers in Buca Faculty of Education. The students who will be the future's teachers could find a chance of improving their digital literacy owing to online and face-to-face activities. At the same time, the teacher training program with the options of face-to-face or online also started with the participation of instructors in the university as a part of the dissemination of the E-Digilit Project.



# Online Meeting

The online meeting of the E-DigiLit project was held on September 09, 2021, with the participation of 13 researchers from the United Kingdom, Croatia, Spain and Turkey.
