# Multiplier Events

Coventry University held three multiplier events for E-DigiLit during March and April 2022 with the overall aim of sharing and disseminating Intellectual Outputs which have been developed through the duration of the project. To maximise the dissemination potential, the events were organised once the Intellectual Outputs had completed (total number of participants = 51). These multiplier events were planned, organised and executed by team members of Coventry University.



UCAM held Multiplier Event on 25.05.2022 at Universidad Católica de Murcia. Welcome by the Vice chancellor for International Relations pablo Salvador Blesa Aledo. The opening speech titled “A brief history of digital literacy”. Digital literacy, intellectual outputs, learning management system, gamification tools and pilot study results were shared with the audience by the Project Team. The conference was also streamed live on the zoom platform.



# Multiplier Events

The E-DigiLit multiplier event held on University of Zagreb at Faculty of organization and informatics in April 2022, aimed to share and disseminate Intellectual Outputs developed and activities performed in the project. To maximise the dissemination potential, the event was organized when Intellectual Outputs were completed. This multiplier event was planned, organized and executed by team members of UNIZG with support and contribution of the leading partner, Dokuz Eylül University.



Dokuz Eylul University, the coordinator of the e-DigiLit project, organized the "E-DigiLit Digital Literacy Conference" as part of the turkey multiplier event to promote the digital literacy course and share the course design with the target audience. This conference was held as a single session on 13.05.2022 in the conference hall of Dokuz Eylül University Buca Education Faculty. The team members of Dokuz Eylül university planned and organised the multiplier event. The conference was also on live on social media accounts. A total number of attendants had been 236 students.



# Teacher Training Process

The Teacher Training (TT) for the E-DigiLit course Digital Literacy was held on University of Zagreb at Faculty of organization and informatics in October and November 2021 in duration of two weeks, with the aim to prepare the to-be-teachers (TT participants) for the piloting the course Digital Literacy. During the TT they get familiar with the course topics, way of performing (teaching and assessment methods), teaching materials.

Coventry University's facilitator training took place during the first week of November 2021. Training involved ten educators who were introduced to the E-DigiLit content and shown how to teach various aspects of it using digital tools such as OneNote, Moodle, and Aula. Once training was complete, facilitators were split into teams of two and supplied with a specific area of the E-DigiLit content that they were expected to deliver to a group of students starting in late November 2021.

UCAM TTP, 10 teachers from the Faculties of Communication, Education and Languages were involved in the project's teacher training. The learning environment included exclusively online activities. At the end of the course, the 10 teachers voluntarily evaluated the course using an online training evaluation form. Teachers' opinions were evaluated in terms of planning and delivery, quality of digital content and digital competence development.

DEU held TTP on 19.11.2021 and 26.11.2021 both face to face and online with the participation of 13 teachers and academicians.



# Student Pilot Study


The piloting of E-DigiLit course Digital Literacy was held on University of Zagreb at Faculty of organization and informatics in November and December 2021 in duration of two weeks, with the aim to test the course, it's aspects, topics, way of performing, teaching materials and to collect opinions from the participants for further improvement of the course.

The course E-DigiLit: Enhancing Student Digital Skills was run for students at Coventry University over 10 online sessions which began in early November 2021. In total 69 registered, 29 attended, and 20 completed the survey online. The course was run by facilitators who had previously undergone training to deliver the content.

UCAM held SP with 76 students from the Faculty of Social Sciences and Communication (51) and the Faculty of Education(25) followed this course in the first quarter of 2022.

The learning environment included online and face-to-face activities pertaining to the blended learning design. At the end of the course, 30 students voluntarily evaluated the course thanks to an online course evaluation form.

In DEU, 100 students registered for this 14-week course in the fall term 2021-2022. The learning environment included both online and face-to-face activities belonging to blended learning design. In first week, all students' registration has been made to Moodle and it has been announced that they can access the course materials from here.
